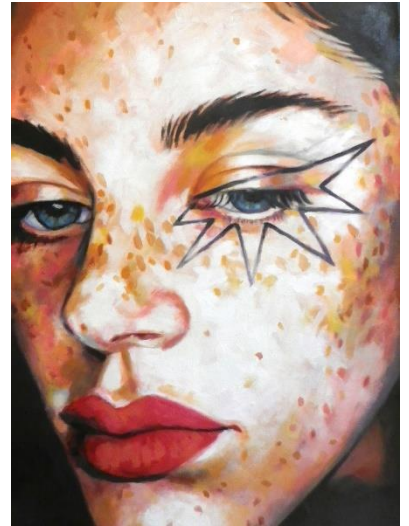

ARTISTS – Duarte Vitoria, Thomas Salliot. Or an ARTIST of your choice.

The Assessment Objectives

AO1: Develop ideas through investigations, demonstrating critical understanding of sources.

- AO2: Refine work by exploring ideas, selecting and experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques and processes.
- AO3: Record ideas, observations and insights relevant to intentions as work progresses.
- AO4: Present a personal and meaningful response that realises intentions and demonstrates understanding of visual language.

Duarte Vitoria: Critical study – Research the artist and include images, written notes and colour drawings. Next, take your own portrait photographs and complete a series of your own drawings.

Thomas Salliot: Critical study – Research the artist and include images, written notes and colour drawings. Next, take your own portrait photographs and complete a series of your own drawings.

(AO1- AO3)

- Plan and present the above critical study work over 6 pages in your A3 sketchbook.
- Research the artists and present a page of their artworks and images.
- Include titles and thorough written notes/analysis.
- Complete a series of observational drawings of the artist's work.
- Now complete a photo shoot of portraits and faces close up.
- Consider close ups, different angles and viewpoints, back drops, props, lighting, framing and composition similar to the artist's work.
- Create contact sheets of 30+ photos with written notes.
- Present the final images in colour in your sketchbook.
- Finally complete several drawings from your photographs using a range of media.
- You will need to ensure high standards of creative presentation and quality of work, including titles and written information explaining your work and ideas.
- Remember to save your work on a USB memory stick!
